Firstly let me congratulate you on getting a place at Emma! I'm writing to you on behalf of ECSU, the Emmanuel College Students' Union, which is the representative body for students at Emma.

ECSU provides a bar, a common room (called the Old JCR), and a shop selling stationery and sweets; we provide funding for sports and societies at Emma, and we act as the primary channel of communication between the students and the College. We also organise a wide range of welfare activities ranging from Week 5 treats all the way through to an extensive de-stress timetable in Easter Term; we are also responsible for organising other College entertainments such as *Emma Ents* and *Emma Comedy Night*.

The daily business of ECSU is managed by the Executive (or Exec for short), members of which have specific responsibilities. If you feel like getting involved you can stand for election during the yearly Exec elections at the end of Michaelmas Term, or get involved with one of the various student committees such as the Access Committee, Ents Committee, Green Committee or *Roar!* Committee.
