2 Catering

CUSU is considering initiating a minibus service that would run between the City Centre and outlying Colleges during the late-night hours. Colleges supporting the scheme would need to provide three volunteers per night as well as a financial contribution.

Exec felt that the scheme was a good idea for the University, but would not be of significant benefit to Emma. ECSU would potentially be willing to provide financial support (using proceeds from the projected increased attendance at Funk da Bar were the scheme to go into effect), but is disinclined to force Emma students to serve as volunteers.

A decision on whether to support the scheme was postponed until after CUSU works out further details at a meeting on Wednesday.
